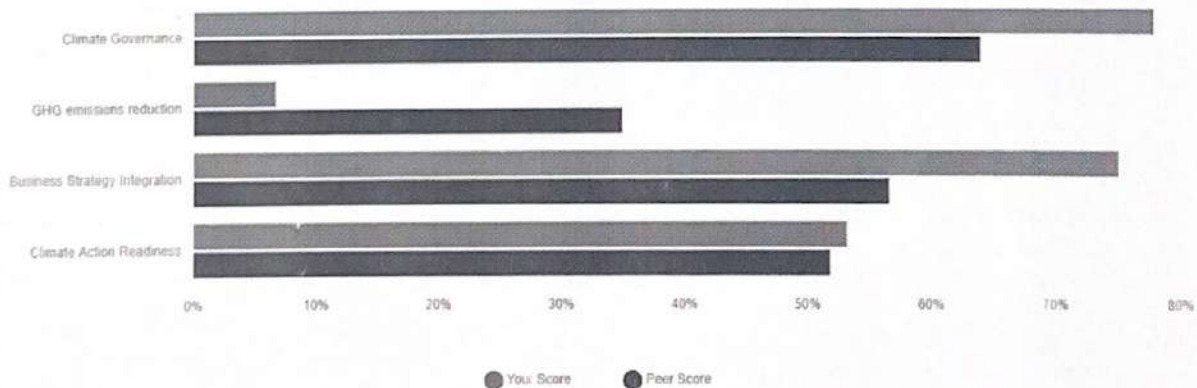

To support this objective and further the company's commitment to sustainability, it is recommended that the Company consider adopting the following action plan.

To reduce GHG emissions: Measure the company's GHG emissions and set an emissions reduction target.	1. Understand how to measure and report GHG emissions and develop a written procedure. 2. Determine the scope of your GHG emissions assessment. Start with measuring scope 1 and scope 2 emissions. 3. Work together with the heads of department to conduct a thorough assessment of business activities, processes, and operations to identify all sources of scope 1 and 2 GHG emissions. 4. Collecting Data: Gather data on business activities, such as energy consumption, fuel usage, and waste generation. 5. Apply the appropriate emission factors corresponding to the activity data to calculate the GHG emissions for each source in unit of metric tonnes of carbon dioxide equivalent (tCO₂e). 6. Establish and review the baseline and base year. 7. Set Emission Reduction Targets for the following year and for near-term (next 5 years). 8. Produce a GHG emission report.	• An individual who is responsible for GHG emissions data collection and reporting. • A comprehensive GHG emissions report that includes relevant context, such as emission scope, sources, reporting boundary, performance indicators, baseline and targets. • An internal review of your emissions calculations and reporting boundary to ensure completeness of your baseline assessment. • Consider engaging a third-party verifier for independent verification and validation.	2 - 8 Weeks

Business Strategy Integration

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Based on the information provided, we recommend that the Company enhance its understanding of climate-related risks and their potential impacts on its business. Currently, there seems to be minimal consideration of climate change in its business operations. To address these climate-related risks, we recommend that the Company adopt the following action plan based on the information provided.

To increase understanding of climate-related risks and educate employees.	1. Conduct screening of climate risks to determine how the physical and transition risks will impact the business operations in the future scenarios. 2. Identify which operations/ activities and supply chains are most vulnerable to climate risks. 3. Provide relevant training to employees in climate-sensitive roles and climate vulnerability. 4. Establish processes and assign responsibilities to address climate risks.	• Inventory of climate risks potentially impacting the business. • Justifications to conduct next level climate risk assessment. • Awareness on climate physical and transition risks which may impact the day-to-day activities and the company's short and long-term business. • Basis to prepare/ update Business Continuity Plan and risk mitigation measures.	3 - 8 Weeks
